POST GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN DISABILITY REHABILITATION & PSYCHOLOGY

PGDRP is a Hands-on Training course approved by RCI with the aim to train candidates in basic knowledge and skills necessary for Rehabilitation Counseling Practice. The course includes core counseling topics including theories of counseling and rehabilitation-specific coursework (e.g. assessment of persons with Physical/Sensory/Developmental/Cognitive disability).

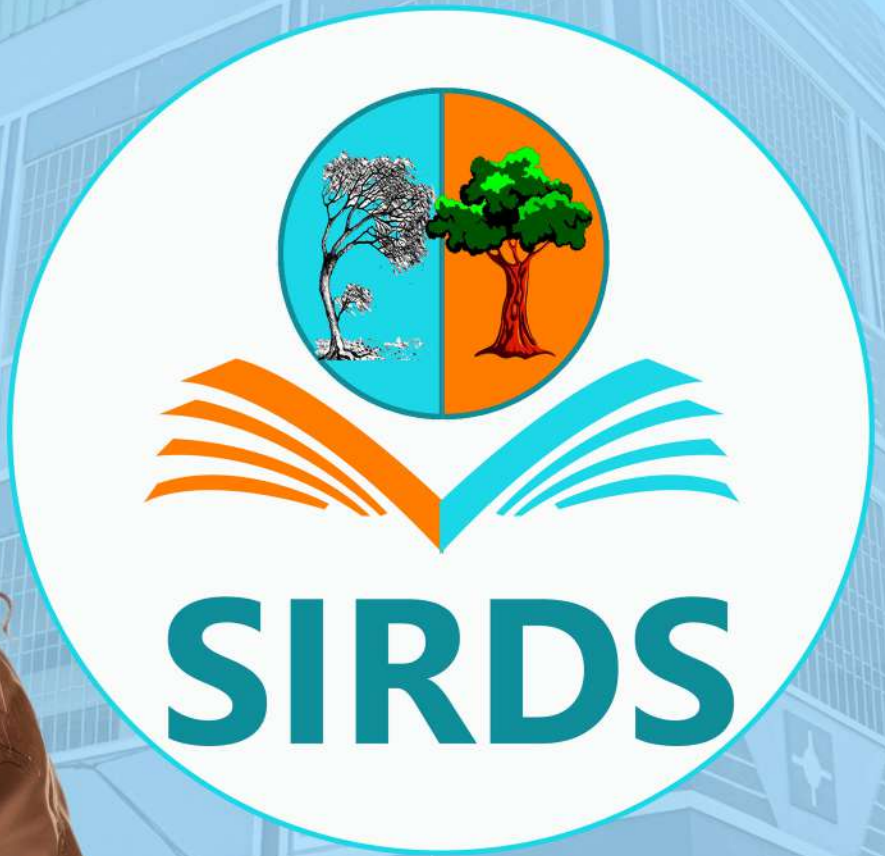
